ABOUT THE ALBUM

Yes! is the new roots-rock album by Wayne Potash for children and families. It's a record that's fun, positive, and affirming for kids. On *Yes!* Wayne's seventh release, his vocals and guitar playing are up front and strong. Over a dozen musical guests join him in the studio providing lots of variety.

Yes! features seven Potash originals and eight covers. You'll hear guitar, bass, and drums that rock, fiddle that's a little bit Celtic and a little bit country, mandolin, banjo, and keyboards that add a playful freshness to the tracks. *I Like Trucks*, *Yes O Yes*, *Flying In An Airplane*, *Old Dan Tucker*, and *Penguins Attention* are already crowd pleasers at Wayne's concerts.

This is an album that families can enjoy, sing along with, and dance to together. The songs have an upbeat message whether you're flying through a rainbow, watching animals in the wild, getting ready for a costume party, riding in a train or a truck, visiting an old farm, or working towards a better world.
